EUCALYPTUS CULTIVATION IN SOUTHERN BAHIA

Tour 4

Pre-congress | September 22nd to 27th

Post-congress | October 6th to 11th





This trip was specially prepared to find out more about the cultivation of the Eucalyptus in the Northeast of Brazil, more specifically in the South of the State of Bahia, that is characterized by three different biomes, these being the Atlantic Forest, Caatinga and Cerrado, which shelter an extensive biological diversity, traditional communities, a rich cultural heritage, tourist sites and springs.

Currently Brazil has 5.7 million hectares planted with Eucalyptus, with an average productivity of $35.7\text{m}^3/\text{ha}/\text{year}$. ▶





It is the most widespread forestry in the country, being widely used in the paper and pulp industry, wood plates, steel mill, besides being widely used for poles and energy.

The region that will be visited has one of the highest yields in Brazil achieved through much development of genetic improvement for well defined climate conditions with high precipitation indices well distributed throughout the year and predominantly clayey soils. ►





You will see the complete cycle of operations at one forest-based companies, Veracel, and will have the opportunity to discuss with specialists from breeding strategy, pest control, planting and maintenance operations to harvesting and transportation of wood for use in the industrial process. The trip will end in Trancoso, time to enjoy a beautiful beach and in a very comfortable environment.

This is a plane trip, starting in Curitiba on Sunday, **September 22nd** and ending **September 27th** in Curitiba or beginning ►





in Curitiba on Sunday, **October 6th** and ending at Guarulhos International Airport on Friday, **October 11th, 2019.**

The trip will be accompanied by a Forest Engineer or Researcher with more than 20 years of experience in forest operations in Brazil

DAY 1

Meeting at the Afonso Pena International Airport, in Curitiba, on the 1st floor in front of the check-in counter of the airline responsible for the flight at 10h. Departure flight from Curitiba at 12h to Porto Seguro, in the state of Bahia. Arrival at 19h10. The transfer will take the group to the 4 stars hotel for check-in and lunch.

The afternoon and evening will be free of activities. Overnight in Porto Seguro.

**Departure time can change without prior notice.*



DAY 2 AND 3

Displacement at 7h to the Veracel factory. The company has 83.7 thousand hectares of planted area. Based on the partnership between two leading companies in the international pulp and paper sector, Fibria, currently Suzano and Stora Enso, which share the company's shareholding control. This has an average annual production of 1.1 million tons of bleached Eucalyptus pulp and a wood consumption of approximately 4 million m³/year. The Veracel plantations are formed ▶

by clones of *Eucalyptus grandis* and *E. urophylla*, age of cut at 7 years and average increase of 38 m³/ha/year. We will meet and discuss with specialists all the forest management of the company, from the production of the seedlings to the wood factory.

Return to the hotel in Porto Seguro in the late afternoon. Night free of activities.



DAY 4

Day of tourism in the region, departure from the hotel at 8h30 to visit the Jaqueira Indigenous Reserve to learn about the customs and traditions of the Pataxós Indians. Return to the hotel for check-out and lunch. Displacement at 15h to Trancoso village, a quiet and charming place, a journey of approximately 1h15. Rest of the day will be free to visit the village of Trancoso.



DAY 5

In the morning, if the tide is low we will visit Recife de Fora and see the natural pools formed by coral reefs. A trip of approximately 1h to this beach. After a swim in these calm waters we will have lunch in a traditional restaurant. Return to the hotel at 15h. Rest of the day reserved for leisure.



DAY 6

Check-out and departure from the hotel at 11h to the airport of Porto Seguro. Flight departing at 14h10, scheduled to arrive at Afonso Pena International Airport in Curitiba at 18h20 (pre-congress) and at Guarulhos International Airport at 16h20 (post-congress).



ADDITIONAL DETAILS

What is included:

- Flight from Curitiba to Porto Seguro on the first day of travel and from Porto Seguro to Curitiba on the last day (pre-congress), or return to Guarulhos International Airport (post-congress). Baggage: 10 kg handbag and a checked bag of up to 23 kg per person.
- Road transport by bus throughout the whole route.
- 3 nights in 4 stars hotel in Porto Seguro - BA.
- 2 nights in 3 stars hotel in Arraial d'Ajuda - BA.
- Breakfast at all accommodations.
- Lunch from the second to the sixth day.
- Tourism in the region of Trancoso and Porto Seguro, including tickets to visit Jaqueira reserve and Recife de Fora.
- Technical visit to company: Veracel.
- Travel insurance.

MEETING POINT FOR DEPARTURE:

- Departure will be at 10h in front of the check-in counter of the airline responsible for the flight, located on Level 1 of Afonso Pena International Airport, in Curitiba, located at Rocha Pombo Avenue - Águas Belas, São José dos Pinhais - PR.
- A sign with IUFRO 2019 will be in place to receive and direct to check-in.
- Make sure, in advance, the transit time to reach the meeting point. Bus, taxi and Uber are some options for displacement.

POINT OF ARRIVAL:

- The trip will end at the Afonso Pena International Airport, in Curitiba, for the pre-congress and at the Guarulhos International Airport in the post-congress. On the post-congress trip we can add a flight to Curitiba at an additional cost. If you want this option, please, contact us.
